

I have originated or been part of teams which established a number of innovative learning experiences for undergraduate and graduate students. I was co-lead of the Interprofessional Rural Placement Project of British Columbia (IRPbc). This project placed teams of health care students (primarily from UBC) to learn and work collaboratively together in rural communities in their field placements. Funded by Health Canada and the BC Ministry of Health the project involved students from 15 disciplines and 20 BC universities and colleges. IRPbc has served as a model for other programs subsequently established in a number of other national and international jurisdictions. I was on the leadership and development team for the Interprofessional Psychosocial Oncology Distance Education Project. Funded by Health Canada and the Canadian Cancer Strategy we developed a series of on-line interprofessional graduate and continuing education courses in English and French through a partnership with nine Canadian universities and their corresponding provincial cancer agencies.

I also established an annual conference that ran for over a decade in my School where community practitioners present a series of workshops over two days on applied skills for undergraduate students. I originated a two day conference that ran for a couple of years in which graduate and doctoral students would offer workshops to undergraduate students. I also developed with colleagues at Providence Heath a unique rotating field placement experience with additional training experiences for graduate students. This concept was further developed by a colleague into what is now known as SWSS.

Additionally I organized a week long summer institute on youth transitions cross listed as a credit course for undergraduate and graduate students and as a continuing education experience for community practitioners. This was developed in conjunction with a number of community partners and four of the School's international post-secondary partners. I arranged external funding for this institute as I did for the development of a graduate course on programme evaluation. This multi-year funded course which I developed in conjunction with a colleague is a six credit course within which students work with a community partner to evaluate programmes of interest to them.

A number of my research projects have involved improving student learning experiences. I was part of a multi - university and community partnership collaboration looking at improving the experiences of Indigenous students in health and human services field placements. I was involved in a multidisciplinary initiative at UBC that developed applied ethics standards and learning processes in international service learning experiences. I was also a member of a team looking at ways of expanding community 'voice' for marginalized populations in health and human service professional programmes at UBC. I am currently involved with a team of researchers from across the country examining new ways of organizing social work field placements. I am also on a team exploring ways to incorporate research based theatre into classroom learning.

7. SCHOLARLY AND PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

(a) *Research or equivalent grants*

My research is focused primarily on marginalized youth, child and adolescent mental health and system change. I lead what is widely recognized nationally and internationally as the leading research initiative on young carers in Canada. I am also a member of an international research collaborative on parental mental illness. I was the co-lead and lead researcher for a number of years of the Interprofessional Network of BC project which examined interprofessional education and practice in the health and human services. This multimillion dollar initiative involved the various BC health authorities, most of the BC colleges and universities and various government ministers. I also originated and co-lead a project to identify a shared research agenda for child, family and youth services in British Columbia. This initiative was a collaboration between six provincial government ministries, most of the province's colleges and universities, the BC Federation of Community Services and the Office of the Representative for Children and Youth. Over 150 Indigenous and non-Indigenous organizations and well over 1500 people were involved in some aspect of the development of the shared research agenda.

I am currently a member of an international team examining ways to deal with child sexual abuse images on-line and another one researching barriers to custom adoption in Indigenous communities. I am involved in projects exploring the impact of patient death on pediatric medical residents and developing a model of community engagement for Indigenous data, information and records. I am also lead on an initiative examining student-to-student abuse within the Indian Residential School System using research based theatre as a vehicle for

knowledge transfer. I am part of a UBC funded research cluster exploring the use of research based theatre as a methodology.
